The Royal Masonic School for Girls, Rickmansworth, Hertfordshire.

The Provincial Grand Master, R.W.Bro. Edward R. Garty, attended by officers of Provincial Grand Lodge entered in procession and opened Provincial Grand Lodge in due form at 10:30 am.

The Acting Provincial Grand Secretary, W.Bro. Darrel Palmer, read the Dispensation from the Grand Master permitting the meeting to be held in Hertfordshire.

The Provincial Grand Director of Ceremonies, W.Bro. John Billett, asked the Provincial Grand Master, if he would wish to welcome the Worshipful Master and brethren of St Pancras Lodge of MMM No.0494, the Banner Lodge, to which the reply was in the affirmative. The Provincial Grand Master thanked the brethren for their support and the hard work that they had put in to set the Temple up the previous evening.

The Travelling Keystone, carried by the Master of Kenton Lodge No 901 escorted by members of the lodge and under the direction of the Provincial Grand Director of Ceremonies, was presented to the Provincial Grand Master. The Provincial Grand Master thanked the brethren for its safe delivery, then returned it to the lodge for safe transmittal to the next recipient.

The minutes of the Installation and Annual General Meeting held on 24th October 2018, having previously been circulated via the Provincial Website and printed in the Order Paper with no amendments or changes being notified. Following a Proposition from W.Bro. Darrel Palmer, seconded by W.Bro. Omaid Hiwaizi and carried unanimously by the brethren, the Provincial Grand Master declared the minutes duly confirmed.

# Report of the Provincial Grand Secretary

This is my first report as Provincial Grand Secretary and what an extraordinary year to report on. The Masonic suspension and the resulting Meeting restrictions have led to a whole new way of working, bringing many challenges but also some opportunities.

The GLMMM has been very innovative and supportive throughout the year, in producing guidance which evolved as the Pandemic progressed, thus allowing Lodges to execute their essential business via Virtual Business Meetings. In return, our members have had to embrace new ways of working and indeed some temporary changes to our ritual.

On behalf of the Secretariat, I would like to thank all the Lodge Secretaries and Scribes for their support in these difficult times and to congratulate them on embracing and executing the temporary changes, thus enabling their Lodges to continue to function in an administrative capacity. We all look forward to that happy day when we can physically meet again and enjoy each other's company.

The Secretariat has not been idle in this enforced period of suspension and restrictions. Under the leadership of W.Bro. Peter Hyde and the excellent support and creativity of Bro. David North, we now have a new leading edge website [www.middlesexmark.org](http://www.middlesexmark.org) On there you will find all the documents and information, that you as Secretary could need. It also maintains up-to-date information on all forthcoming events, a Lodge meeting calendar and much more.

The Secretary's Guide has been produced for all Secretaries and Scribes, which covers everything you could possibly need to know, regarding running and administering a Lodge. This has been widely distributed and is also available on the Website. The GLMMM has issued over 24 documents, giving guidance as the pandemic evolved and these are available on the Website in one document entitled "Consolidated Guidance". All these documents are live and updated continually.

During the Summer, many hours were spent by the Secretariat in conjunction with the Secretaries/Scribes, and other Orders in updating the Yearbook. To reduce Lodge Costs only one hard copy will be provided to each Lodge. However, an electronic copy of the Yearbook will be available on the website, immediately after the AGM. The Provincial By Laws are printed in the yearbook and are also available on the website.

Greater access has now been granted to Lodge Secretaries and Scribes on Keystone-on-Line (KoL), <https://kol.mmh.org.uk/Default.aspx> thus allowing to them to carry out read/write activities. It is hoped that this facility will result in faster and more accurate updating of the information on KoL.

During the year we said farewell to All Hallows Lodge No 0986, Mark and Royal Ark Mariner, as it handed in its warrant and which is held in abeyance. There is also a warm welcome to the return of George Parker Lodge No 1316, which has been reinvented as a Golfers Lodge with an initial membership of 18.

Since last year's report, the number of members and memberships have dropped slightly in both the Mark and the Royal Ark Mariner. This is not surprising as the Suspension of Masonic Activity has resulted in quite a backlog of Candidates awaiting admission and equally joining members from both inside and outside the Province. Sadly, there have been several deaths and a few resignations from our more elderly members.

W.Bro. Reg Austin, who has taken on a number of tasks, not usually required of the Assistant Secretary.

W.Bro. Tony Hammell, Provincial Grand Registrar, who has worked so diligently in the background, keeping KoL up to date and maintaining a watchful eye on the statistics.

W.Bro. Paul Lane who has worked so hard over the years, maintaining the Year Book and many other duties.

W.Bro. Omaid Hiwaizi for organizing the escorts for the Provincial visits.

# The Charity Report

For W.Bro. Headley O'Brien it has been a remarkably interesting first year as Provincial Grand Charity Steward.

Last year the Provincial Grand Master requested that each Mark and Royal Ark Mariner Lodge donate the arms collection from one meeting to the Middlesex Mark Benevolent Fund. This would enable the Fund to continue to give prompt assistance to our members where needed and to support those Provinces hosting the annual Mark Benevolent Fund Festival. Adequate funding would also enable us to continue to give substantial support to three local hospice charities chosen by the Provincial Grand Master. It was great to see a visual presence for all three at our AGM in October 2019. It is hoped that this involvement by them will continue.

Disbursements totalling £18,500 were made during the year to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020. Since then, the Trustees have authorised further disbursements of £2500 to each of the three hospices and £3100 to the 2021 MBF Festival hosted by East Lincs.

The hospices are going through very bleak times at present. Most of their fundraising events had to be cancelled and their charity shops closed because of the Coronavirus. The massive reduction in their income has led to severe cuts to the services they offer and some job losses.

They need our help more than ever. Therefore, The Provincial Grand Master requests the continuing support of each Lodge by donating the proceeds of one alms collection to the MMBF.

Fortunately, the St. Valentine's Lunch was held at Uxbridge prior to the Coronavirus restrictions being imposed. A most enjoyable event which raised £1200 for the MMBF, thanks to Chris Nixon, Paul Craker, and their enthusiastic band of helpers.

Thanks also to Victor Burton who organises and runs the Bonus Ball Game, which has raised over £3600 for the MMBF since it was launched in October 2018. We urge all Lodges to consider joining in. For £1 per week (£10 for 10 weeks) a prize of £30 each week is paid to the successful member with the balance going to the MMBF. Please visit our website for details and an application form.

During the suspension of Freemasonry, our Provincial Grand Master and members of the Provincial Executive, with help from family members, sourced and delivered hampers of toiletries, fruit, sweets, and other goodies to 14 care homes in our Mark Province. They were very gratefully received by all the staff of this very hard working sector.

The Provincial Grand Almoner, W.Bro. Roger Tomlinson, continues to thank all the Lodge Almoners for their dedication and continued hard work in respect of their members and Lodge widows. At no time has it been more important to maintain close contact than in these most trying of times. As always, we rely on others for the free flow of information so that they can optimise their role. They all have our highest regard and thanks.

Again, sadly, we have lost many members to the Grand Lodge Above, all of them distinguished and greatly missed. On behalf of the Province, W. Bro. Roger has marked their passing by sending cards, flowers and making telephone calls as appropriate. There have also been many approaches for advice and assistance regarding financial support and other forms of distress which have been handled with positive results.

When visiting other Lodges, the importance of the role of the Lodge Almoner has been stressed particularly to new appointees.

A very unusual year for us all with the advent of the Covid-19 virus dominating our lives and curtailing our Masonic activities. Hopefully, you are all managing to cope with this major intrusion into normality. Also, at the time of writing, it appears that very few of us have been infected or suffered severe consequences-long may it continue. We all face an uncertain future, but the role of the Lodge Almoner remains undiminished and more important than ever.

The Provincial Grand Almoner and the Provincial Grand Charity Steward wish to thank all Lodge Almoners, Charity Stewards, Secretaries, Scribes and the MMBF Trustees for their help during the year. Their co-operation has been very much appreciated.

The accounts for the year to March 2020 show an increase in total income compared with the preceding year.

This was attributable entirely to the most welcome income received from the Bonus Ball scheme. Payments made during the year included £5000 donated to each of the three hospices we support, namely, Shooting Star Children's Hospices, Harlington and St Luke's. There were also payments totalling £3000 related to the 2020 MBF Festival hosted by Kent.

During the current financial year the Trustees have already approved further donations to the three hospices and to the 2021 MBF Festival hosted by East Lancashire.

In October 2019 V.W.Bro. Michael Crombie and W.Bro. Paul Craker stood down as Trustees having made most valuable contributions to the work of the Fund. I and the other Trustees are most grateful for their past support. They have been replaced as Trustees by W.Bro. Headley O'Brien and W.Bro. Ian Wassell.

The charitable payments made would not have been possible without the past generosity of Lodges and of individual Brethren. That generosity continues to be greatly appreciated by the Trustees and it is hoped that Lodges will continue where possible to donate the alms collection from one meeting each year to the Fund.
